KCC in accordance with its approved budget opens an annual bid for film projects. The annual bid usually opens in March where around 20 film projects are subsidized.

KCC supports feature films, short films, documentary films, animated films, script development and minority co-productions.

KCC is a member of the European Film Promotion, patron of European Film Academy and since 2014 KCC is eligible to submit a film for the Academy Awards consideration.



SYNOPSIS:

The story takes place in March 1999, during the period of NATO bombings, in Kosovo. There, a massive ethnic displacement of Albanians is happening. Terror, fear, insecurity, and hunger have plagued Gjakova, a city near the Kosovo-Albania border. The events of the film unfold during the bombing campaign in a timeframe of 70 days.

Although, during the narrative of the film, comic situations and moments of humour turn up naturally, every now and again evading the bleak situations that penetrate the fable of the

film. Initially, the film develops in two parallel lines. Later on, they converge, tie into one joint thread, and eventually each returns to its own fate. It is a film for both, adults and children.
